Cabin Prices

There are two sets of cabin prices. The first is the basic cruise fare promotion. The second is the "Have It All" Promotion which includes several amenities.

Cruise prices are based on volume and fluctuate over time. The following prices are based on a group discount but are subject to change without notice. For the best rate, book as soon as possible.

BASIC CRUISE FARE PROMOTION

Inside cabins start from \$449 per person Ocean View cabins start from \$799 per person Verandahs start from \$849 per person

Cabin prices vary depending on location. Taxes, fees, and port expenses are additional at \$167.00 per person. Gratuities of \$16 per person per day, (or \$17.50 for suites) can either be prepaid or paid at the end of cruise.

HAVE IT ALL PROMOTION

Amenities include the Surf Wifi Package, one complimentary shore excursion per person (up to \$100), one free night of dining in the specialty restaurant, and the Signature Beverage Package. Choose from a large selection of beer, wine, spirits, and cocktails, plus soft drinks, specialty coffees and more.

Payment Plans

A deposit may be due that the time of booking. If you have cruised with Holland America before, you may be entitled to additional savings or cruise credits.

You are also entitled to the benefits of the Holland America loyalty program. If you do not already have one, our personal cruise planner, Tracie Smith, will offer you a "Mariner I.D." and membership in the program.

Final payment is due December 31, 2023.

Guests can join the voyage up until 3 days prior to departure, however from December 31st onward, anyone joining would need to make full payment instead of a deposit followed by final payment.

Cancellations and Refunds

There is no cancellation fee and you are entitled to a full refund prior to December 31, 2023.

After December 31, a cancellation fee schedule begins. You can add a cancellation protection plan at any time prior to making your final payment.

There are two cancellation protection plans available. The Standard Plan allows trip cancellation for any reason up to the day before departure, with an 80 percent refund. Standard plans start at \$79 per person. The Platinum Plan allows trip cancellation for any reason up to the day before departure, with a 90 percent refund. Platinum plans start at \$99 per person.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What do I have to do before the cruise?

Guests are required to provide Holland America Cruise Lines with check-in information by completing their Online Check-in and selecting their Arrival Appointment, within 90 days of the departure and no later than midnight (eastern time) prior to the sailing date. Holland America recommends using a desktop computer should you encounter connectivity issues with your mobile device while completing Online Check-in.

Are Single Cabins Available?

Yes, single occupancy cabins are available at a significantly higher cost. Please contact our personal cruise consultant, Tracie Smith, for details (see *Make a Reservation*, above). Cabins are designed to accommodate two persons and some may accommodate three or four. The supplement for a third or fourth guest is \$349 plus \$155 taxes and port fees, regardless of cabin class. Prices are subject to change without notice.

What are my travel options for getting to the Cruise Terminal at the Port of San Diego?

What government documents are required for travel to Mexico?

A valid U.S. passport, U.S. passport card, <u>OR</u> a valid driver license <u>together with</u> a copy of your original birth certificate or certified copy is required for entry into Mexico and re-entry into the United States. Is Holland America offering any special perks to our group?

How should I plan for shore excursions?

There are many things to see and do at our three ports of call, Santa Barbara, Monterey and Ensenada. The Have It All cruise package includes a \$100 per person shore excursion credit when booked through Holland America Cruise Lines (https://www.hollandamerica.com/en_US/shore-excursions.html). Alternatively, you can explore on your own or with your classmates, or book guided tours or activities through third party companies such as Shore Excursions Group (https://www.shoreexcursionsgroup.com/) or activity brokers such as Viator (https://www.viator.com/) or directly with the activity provider.

Wait. The itinerary changed. Why are we no longer stopping at Monterey?

Because Monterey city officials are a bunch of weenies. Although the city cannot legally prohibit cruise ships from visiting, it has imposed such onerous regulations and procedures that most cruise lines have decided they can no longer live with them. A change to the itinerary was announced in late summer and San Francisco has replaced Monterey as a port of call.

Can I bring my own beverages on board?

Ensenada, 67 miles south of the border, is hedonistic Tijuana's cosmopolitan sister. The city has a quirky mix of just-offthe-boat cruise shippers, drive-by tourists from California, visitors from mainland Mexico and seen-it-all locals. In case you've forgotten you're in Mexico (what with all those US dollars and English menus), just look up: a Mexican flag, so large it's probably visible from space, flutters proudly over the malecón (waterfront promenade).
